



2008 MAJORS TRYOUT AGREEMENT

The purpose of the agreement is to make sure that each candidate for a Pacific Little League (PLL) Majors tryout is aware of his or her responsibilities, commitment and the National Little League regulations that govern the Majors division of Little League Baseball. PLL has also adopted additional regulations that ensure the level of play for the Majors Division is instructional, competitive and fun for all those who participate. This agreement must be signed, and on record with the Majors/Minors Player Agent before each candidate will be assigned a Majors tryout time.

TRYOUT PROCESS:

It is mandatory each candidate attend the entire tryout for his or her assigned group on Sat., Feb. 9th, 2008, or the assigned alternate tryout day, Mon., Feb. 11th. There will be no exceptions to the PLL rule. Each candidate will receive a tryout time that will be posted on the PLL web site (www.pacificlittleleague.com) on Fri. Feb. 8th. Candidates for the PLL Majors Division shall be Little League age 10, 11 or 12 and must reside within the PLL boundaries.

DRAFT PROCESS:

PLL Majors players are selected by a draft process with the remaining players being placed onto a Minor League team following the Major League draft. Each candidate and their legal guardian should review the General Information and Local Rules adopted by PLL that administrate the policies of the Majors draft process. These rules are available at the PLL web site, at registration, or from the Majors/Minors Player Agent.

GAME PLAY:

Players are asked to be at all team practices (min. 2 per week preseason) and games (usually one weeknight and one Sat. game each week). **Every player on a team roster is guaranteed a minimum of six (6) defensive outs and bat at least one (1) time for each game per Regulation IV (I) in the Office Regulations and Playing Rules of Little League Baseball.** The number of innings played each game is also dependent on the amount of practice time attended as well as the following of team rules as set by each Majors Team Manager.
